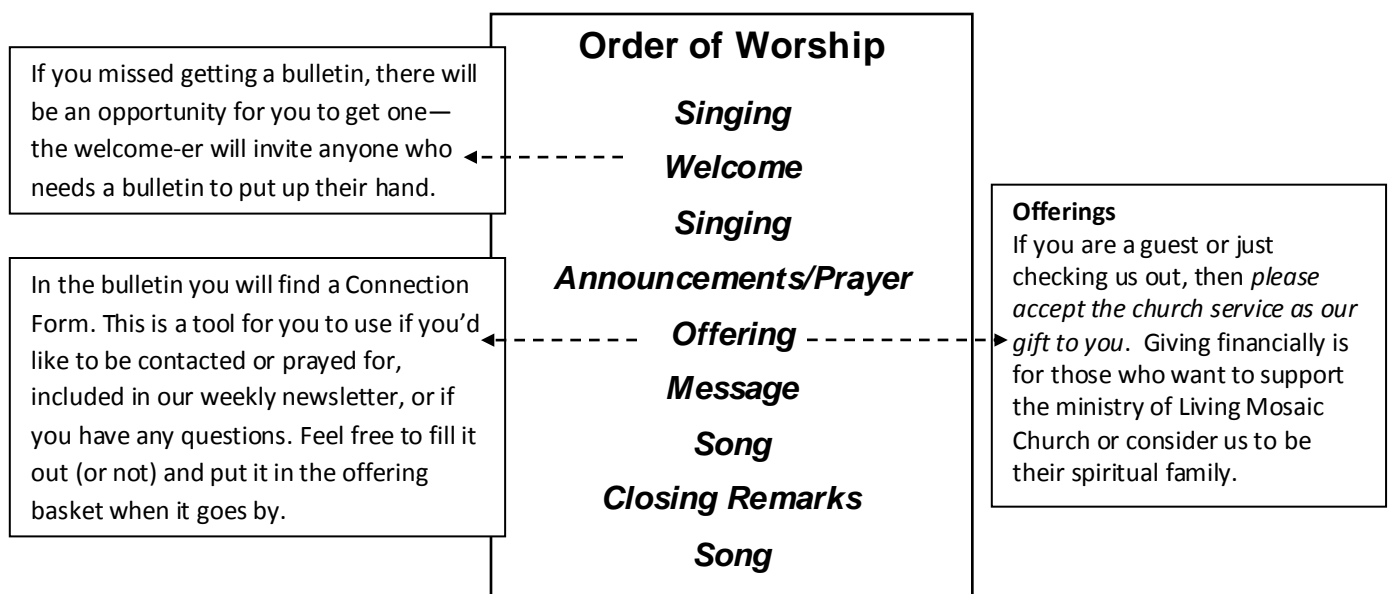


What to Expect at our church service

- When you walk through the doors, there will be a welcome table, with a friendly greeter. They may give you a bulletin/program that outlines the services, give our staff contact info, and some general info/announcements related to our church. Now this isn't your last chance to get one of these before the service—hold fast if this step was overlooked.
- If you arrive any time after 9:30am, there will be fresh coffee, baked goods, fruit & cheese, for your morning pick-me-up. Some other people will be milling around, and more than happy to chat with you and show you around. There are also some pictures on the wall that you can glance at if it's just too early to be carrying on a coherent conversation....mind you, they're graduation photos of children you probably don't know, seeing as we meet in an elementary school.
- The staff should be recognizable by some sort of Living Mosaic clothing—depending on how awake they were when they got dressed in the morning. They're nice people. Check out the staff page for info/pictures of them.
- If you have children, Childcare is available for children ages 0-2 in the Little Lambs Nursery which is situated at the far end of the school's hallway going left of the washrooms. You can bring them there before the service, so you can have a chance to mingle and grab some food! For ages 3-10, there is also specific programming; your children will be dismissed part-way through the church service, attend the program, and they will re-enter the church service towards the end (probably during the last time of singing). Of course, if they'd feel more comfortable staying with you through the service, that is fine as well.
- Just before 10am, the worship leader for that Sunday will probably start playing, maybe even start some congregational singing....they're gently trying to get everyone in some sort of seat.
- At 10am the church service will begin. This is generally what the format looks like: (it's not really intricate as you can see...don't worry about getting lost)



- After the church service... there will be lots of people hanging around & talking. Feel free to stick around, introduce yourself to someone (someone may introduce themselves to you...), eat some more of the food that is definitely still there from before the service. We'd love a chance to talk you, although if you have somewhere to be, that's fine too! We hope that you might come back sometime and get to know the church better.
